2007 Proposed By Laws Change

Proposed Bylaw Amendment

As a result of the standing down and inactivation of all the Active Force Recon Companies in our Marine Corps, all prior Force Recon units formed up and became elements of the new US SOCOM (Special Operations Command) in the formation of MARSOC. Our FRA must adjust its Bylaws accordingly. <u>If we do not do this, then FRA will go the way of the Raider</u> <u>Association</u>, in that no new younger members coming into FRA will cause it to run out of members and it will have to cease existence.

In order to avoid this, both our President, MGySgt. Joe Settelen, Vice President Joe Tablada, President-Elect Andy Christian, our Executive Director Dick Sasser and our Specially Appointed By Laws Committee (Charles Bucholtz, Lew Kern and Wayne Lingfelter) and others have conferred and tasked me to address the qualifications for membership for FRA, both Regular Membership and Associate Membership. After considerable discussion, we have all agreed to the enclosed simple proposed Bylaw change that will cover all Marines and Corpsmen in MARSOC that are under the 0321 MOS.

Article XI of our Bylaws does not permit signing of proposed changes to Bylaws by any officer of the Board of Directors or the Executive Board, which is why the above officers, Board Members and Bylaws Committee asked me to prepare a Motion for Change of the Bylaws and to obtain signatures of five Regular Members who concurred in the proposed change. You will see that the Motion now changes the requirements for Regular and Associate membership to reflect that there are no longer Force Recon Companies within the Marine Corps and to acknowledge that the former Force Recon Companies are now members of MARSOC as part of SOCOM.

I now have in-hand, signatures of 7 Regular members (including myself) who are not on the Board or are currently serving as Officers of the Association. I selected the signators at random, ensuring a spectrum that include WWII Amphib Recon (John Sebern), the Amphib units between wars (Pepe LeBlanc), and Force Recon (both ancient and new) [Bruce Meyers, Troy Mitchell, Sam Moyer and Pat Ryan]. I have enclosed photo static copies of each of these seven signatures to provide to our Secretary Bob Rowen. I shall personally bring the originals of these signatures to FRA Charleston 2007.

We believe the changes proposed bring us up to our current manning structure and includes all former Force Recon personnel now serving in MARSOC. It does not include Recon Battalion members other than those already qualified as Associate Members. Recon Battalion Marines have their own Association.

MOTION FOR PROPOSED CHANGE IN FRA BYLAWS

We the undersigned Regular Members of FRA, not presently serving as an FRA officer or a member of the FRA Board of Directors, recommend the following change in the current Bylaws under the authority set forth in **ARTICLE XI AMENDMENTS.**

Under **ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP**, an addition of those Marines and Corpsmen serving in MARSOC in SOCOM (established in 2005):

(1) **REGULAR MEMBERS**, add at the end of current eligible:

"...those reconnaissance-trained Marines and Corpsmen serving from the establishment of MARSOC in 2005, that carry the MOS 0321..."

(2) ASSOCIATE MEMBERS, add at after "Marine SOCOM Detachment 1: "...or MARSOC"

(ASSOCIATE MEMBERS, will now read:

"...Associate membership may include Recon Battalion, ANGLICO Marines, Non-reconnaissance trained personnel of Marine SOCOM Detachment 1 or MARSOC and Corpsmen of these units. Associate Members may not serve as officers or on the Board of Directors of the Association."

I agree with the above proposed changes in the FRA bylaws covering those eligible For both REGULAR MEMBERSHIP and ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP.

"ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP

Membership in the Association shall be open to all persons interested in furthering the purposes of the Association, who apply for membership and conform to the duties of members as provided by the Bylaws. Membership shall consist of the categories hereinafter defined.

REGULAR MEMBERS. All officers and enlisted members of the Armed Forces of the United States of America or her Allies who are now serving, or who have served, with any Force Reconnaissance Company, Regular or Reserve. Deep Recon Platoons of Marine Division Reconnaissance Battalion; or personnel who served in Amphibious Reconnaissance units between 1943 and 1958; and those reconnaissance-trained Marines and Corpsmen, currently serving or having served in Marine SOCOM Detachment I. Only Regular Members may serve as officers or on the Board of Directors of the Association.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERS. Civilians and veterans of the U.S. Armed Forces and Allies who did not serve with a Force Reconnaissance Company, but who did make a significant development in or advancement to operational procedures or techniques inherent in Force Reconnaissance operations or who made a valuable and unique contribution to either operational Force Reconnaissance or MARSOC units or to the Association. Associate membership may include Recon Battalion, ANGLICO Marines, Non-reconnaissance trained personnel of Marine SOCOM Detachment 1 and Corpsmen of these units. Associate Members may not serve as officers or on the Board of Directors of the Association...

"ARTICLE XI AMENDMENTS

These Bylaws may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the Regular Membership voting at the time at any annual, regular or special meeting of the Association, provided that the proposed amendment has been submitted in writing to the Secretary and transmitted to each Regular Member at least fifteen (15) days prior to the presentation of the amendment to the Membership.

Any proposed amendment to the Bylaws must be signed by five Regular Members in good standing. Upon the consideration of any proposed amendment to these Bylaws at any meeting, amendments thereto on the same subject matter may be offered, voted and accepted at the same meeting without any prior notice."
