<u>Honoring a Fallen Force Recon Hero:</u> <u>2nt LT Terrence Graves, 3rd Force Reconnaissance Company</u>

On Friday, June 2, 2017, the Marine TBS Community at MCB Quantico dedicated a new residence hall in honor of 2nt LT Terrence Graves, 3rd Force Reconnaissance Company. 2nd Lt Graves was killed in action in February, 1968 in Quang Tri Provence, RVN, and was posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor for his heroism. To further honor our fallen Recon Brother, the FRA staff partnered with the active duty training staff at RTS, MCB Camp Pendleton who built a spectacular memorial paddle encased in glass to protect and preserve the Medal of Honor and the other decorations awarded to 2nd Lt Graves. The paddle was presented to the TBS command and will hang in a place of prominence in the new Graves Hall. Also, during the dedication, FRA President, Al Sniadecki, accompanied by Vice President, Dick Ashton announced the naming of a 2017 FRA Scholarship in Terry Graves' honor. Mr. Sniadecki explained that as long as the Force Recon Association exists, "...heroes like Terry Graves and all of our fallen Brothers would never be forgotten."

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May, 2017 saw a storied Marine career move to its final chapter as LtCol Andrew Christian announced his retirement and subsequently relinquished command of his battalion on 25 May 2017. Few contemporary Marines have earned the level of respect, allegiance, and affection that Andy has earned.
